Whimsical Wrap Class

Create a beautiful, lightweight whimsical wrap using water soluble plastic ~ yes, that's right, water soluble plastic! You will be working with sumptuous natural yarns and gorgeous ribbons, hand-dyed Merino roving and silk fabric, all colour coordinated for you in advance. Very basic machine stitching skills required. Each person must have a sewing machine.

Approximately 5 hour class

Woven Bag Class

In this class, you will be supplied with a weaving loom, warp thread, a coordinated selection of yarns and ribbons, needles, beads and a cord handle for your bag. Using a very simple weaving technique, you will create an awesome bag to use during the day or as a sumptuous evening bag.

Full day class

Stephanie's Freeform Bag Class

For this 3 day class, you will be provided with a box full of fancy yarns and ribbons, a bag frame, knitting needles, a crochet hook, bag handles, a hand-made embellishment that can be used as a button or pin, embroidery threads and beads. During the first 2 days, you will learn how to create zany freeform knitted clusters ~ you can add crochet if you know how but it isn't necessary! You don't need to know any fancy stitches, garter stitch (simple knitting) is fine because it is the different textured yarns and ribbons that create the interesting clusters that make up the bag.

After the first 2 days, you will be given 2 weeks (or longer, the class will decide) to make enough clusters for your bag. On the third day, you will come back to class with all your clusters and learn how to put everything together to create an amazing freeform bag.

3 day class

Stephanie's Freeform Collar Class

Similar in format to the freeform bag class, you will be provided with a box full of fancy yarns instead of making a bag, you will make a stunning collar. This is also a three day class, the two days will be spent learning how to make the freeform clusters, no fancy stitches, just simple knitting (and crochet if you know how) then a break for two weeks to allow you to create enough pieces to make the collar. Then another one day class to learn how to put the collar together and you will be the proud owner of a gorgeous freeform collar.

3 day class

The Ancient Art of Felting in the 21st Century

People have been making felt for thousands of years. Today we don't need to drag the felt around behind a horse to 'fix' it, we use bubble wrap instead! If this sounds intriguing, this is the class for you. You will be provided with a bag full of gorgeous, hand dyed merino roving and a pile of luscious embellishments including fancy yarns, silk roving, silk threads, organza, sequins and embroidery threads to enable you to create a unique piece of cloth.

1 day class

Advanced Felting Class

To participate in this class, you must have attended one of the Introduction to Felting classes with Stephanie held at The Fibre Studio in 2008. During this class we will make a hat and a shawl using the nuno felting technique. Go to bed early the night before as you will be working hard and learning some new techniques in this class!

1 day class

Luscious Landscape Class

During this two day class you will create a background using hand dyed fabric, water soluble plastic and a selection of yarns and ribbons. On the second day, you will embellish the background to make either an autumn scene or a waterfall.

2 day class

Needlefelting

Using long, barbed needles and Corriedale wool roving, you will create an intriguing floral or abstract design using the needlefelting process. It's a lot of fun and after the first few minutes, you won't stick the needle in your finger by mistake!

1 day class

Creative Beading and Stitching

Choose from one of several unique Pacifica designs printed onto a hand-stretched artist's canvas. Then, using lovely hand-dyed embroidery thread and very, very simple stitches and beading techniques, you will produce a stunning piece of art for your home or to give as a gift.

1 day class

Embellishments Galore!

Spend a great day making lots of fun and funky embellishments for pocket books, buttons and brooches using a variety of techniques and materials including Angelina fibre, Tyvek, Polymer Clay, Felt, beads and more. You will take home a lot of goodies as well as ideas for future projects. All craft materials will be provided.
